Special Committee on Health
April 25, 2006**

Everyone confirmed their email addresses for communication purposes. Nikki gave a brief review of the Cities Readiness Initiative and the committee progress to date:

- Point of Distribution (POD) will be Town Hall.
- Communication will be Code Red (reverse 911 system).
- Recruit plenty of volunteers and assign to job descriptions.

There are several items that the volunteers need to do at this time:

1. Sign up for not more than 3 job descriptions (These are posted upstairs in the village office-30 village square).
2. Borrow and read the National Incidence Command System-700 training booklet from the village office (or download it off the FEMA website).
3. Take the post-test on-line from the FEMA website
<http://training.fema.gov/emiweb/IS/is700.asp>
4. After you pass your exam, you will get a certificate. Make a copy of your NIMS-700 certificate and put it in Nikki's mailbox at the village office.
5. House bill 9 has passed and gives liability protection if a volunteer is credentialed with the state. All volunteers should sign-up at
www.serveohio.org under the Ohio Medical Reserve Corp-Register. **OR**
6. Attend the Tri-state Medical Reserve Corp Training (TMRC) being offered at Cintas Center Xavier University on May 6, 2006. TMRC Volunteers are eligible to receive training and may volunteer locally, regionally, or nationally. RSVP at 946-7808.

The committee still needs many more volunteers. Nikki will write a Press Release with Wally Cordes to get the message out to the media. Also, local churches and civic groups will be contacted for volunteers. ***SPREAD THE WORD!***

At subsequent meetings, other more immediate public health risks and ways to prepare Glendale residents for them, will be addressed.

The next meeting will be planned once we get our pool of volunteers selected and trained; and when we have a draft of the emergency layout of Town Hall to review.
